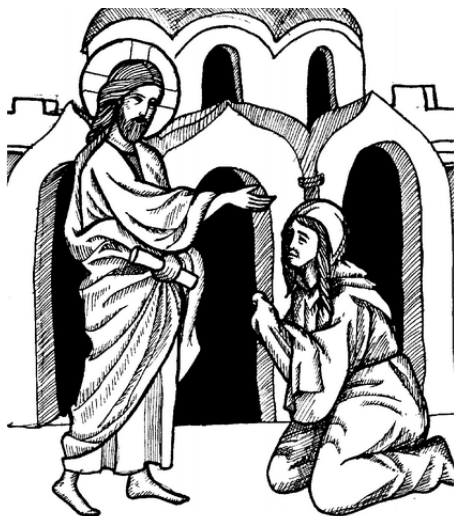
SCRIPTURE READINGS
